- Music Together song collections have outstanding arrangements that are fun, sophisticated and loved by children and grownups alike. The music includes a delightful mix of both original songs and traditional tunes from the folk, jazz and world music genres in a wide variety of tonalities and meters, providing a rich buffet of 'ear food.'

TUITION INCLUDES

- A live, online 30-minute 'home class' at your designated class time that is recorded so you can enjoy it again. Plus, the option to attend another live online class or two each week and receive their recordings.
- A 15-20 minute mini session each Tuesday at 7 pm led by different teachers in rotation plus a few longer online group events, including at least one dance party!
- A ten-minute private online session with your teacher where you'll sing your favorite songs.
- A professionally-recorded CD of the class activities: songs, rhythmic rhymes and tonal and rhythm patterns—and access to our free app that allows you to download or stream these same materials.
- A songbook/storybook with delightful illustrations that welcomes you and your child into the music.
- Loads of bonus material: coloring pages, activity sheets, parent ed videos and more.

REGISTRATION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS and classes often fill quickly, so please register early to avoid disappointment. We cannot guarantee your first choice of class times, but will do our best to honor your request and appreciate your flexibility.

Please note that under-enrolled classes (fewer than six children registered) may be canceled and we will do our best to find another class time that works for you. If we are not able to find you an alternative class, we will issue a full refund.

MAKE-UPS You will receive the two recorded classes each week, whether or not you are able to join the live class, so you are always able to make up online any classes missed.

TUITION/REGISTRATION FEE For our eight-week summer session, tuition for the first registered child in a family is \$159 and \$79 for each additional sibling eight months or older. Infants under eight months on the first day of the summer session (born after October 20, 2019) attend free with a paying sibling as do older, school-aged children.

All infants are welcome; if they are not siblings of a paying child, their tuition is \$159, the same as the first registered child in a family. There is a one-time-only registration fee of \$15 for families new to our program. This fee is waived for our Parks and Rec and Community Ed locations.

Tuition refunds will be given only if requested at least one week before the start of the summer session, so on or before June 13, 2020. After this date, credit toward future sessions may be issued in special circumstances but refunds are not given. For classes in locations where Parks and Rec and/or Community Ed departments process registrations and take payments, their respective refund policies apply.

MUSIC TOGETHER ONLINE SUMMER 2020 CLASS SCHEDULE

Our 8-week Summer Session begins June 20-26. There are no classes July 4.

All classes listed below are mixed-age classes for infants, toddlers, preschoolers and their accompanying adults with the exception of the Tuesday 11:15 am 'Rhythm Kids' class which is for K- 2nd graders. All classes will be held online. The locations listed are where classes would have been held if we'd been able to hold in-person classes. We encourage you to choose a location you will be able to attend once we are back to in-person classes so that you can continue to build relationships with the same teacher and with the other families in your class. However, you are free to choose any teacher, any location.

The summer session includes a live, online 30-minute 'home class' at your designated class time that is recorded so you can enjoy it again and again, plus the option to attend another live online class or two each week and receive their recordings. We'll also have weekly 15-20 minute mini sessions each Tuesday at 7 pm taught by different teachers in rotation.
