- Music Together song collections have outstanding arrangements that are sophisticated yet easily accessible and are loved by children and grownups alike. The music includes a delightful mix of original songs and traditional folk tunes both from the US and from many other countries around the world in a wide variety of tonalities and meters, providing a rich buffet of 'ear food.'

## FALL TUITION INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING

- Ten 45-minute weekly classes at your designated class time and place with engaging activities you can do all week long.
- The professionally produced 'Flute' song collection that you can access using our free 'Music Together' app or via the optional CDs we'll offer. It includes songs, rhythmic rhymes and tonal and rhythm patterns.
- A beautifully illustrated 'Flute' songbook/storybook that welcomes you and your child into the music
- 'Music and Your Child: A Guide for Parents and Caregivers,' a booklet-sized crash course in early childhood music development that will help you help your child get the most out of our classes. You'll also receive a growth chart to help you identify and celebrate your child's milestones in music development.
- An opportunity to meet new friends—for both for you and for your child—and to build community.

**REGISTRATION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS** and classes often fill quickly, so please register early to avoid disappointment. We try to limit each class to 12 registered children and their accompanying adults and up to two infant siblings.

Please note that under-enrolled classes (fewer than six children) may be canceled and we will do our best to find another class time that works for you. If we are not able to find you an alternative class, we will issue a full refund.

**MAKE-UPS.** We offer in-person make-up classes using our online 'Make-Up Scheduler' under 'Enrolled Families'

**TUITION/REGISTRATION FEE** For the ten-week Fall Session, tuition for the first registered child in a family is \$204 and \$124 for each additional sibling eight months or older. Infants under eight months on the first day of the fall session (born after Jan 20, 2025) attend free with a registered sibling. All infants are welcome. If they are not siblings of a paying child, their tuition is \$204, the same as that of the first registered child in a family. There is a one-time-only registration fee of \$15 for families new to our program. This fee is waived for those who register with our Parks and Rec and Community Ed partners. Tuition refunds will be given only if requested at least one week before the start of the fall session, so on or before Sept 13, 2025. After this date, credit toward future sessions may be issued in special circumstances but refunds will not be given. For classes in locations where Parks and Recreation and/or Community Education departments process registrations and take payments, their respective refund policies apply.

All classes below are mixed-age for infants, toddlers and preschoolers—and the grownups who love them—except these in-person Rhythm Kids classes for K-2nd graders: Mon 4:15 pm in St Louis Park, Wed 3:15 pm in Plymouth, Sat 11 am in Edina and Sun 3:30 pm in Shoreview. We also have a Tues 4:30 pm Rhythm Kids Online class.
